## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by
- the 'rules' as defined in the RRS,
  - the Equipment Rules of Sailing will apply,
  - the RC 44 Event Calls
  - national authority prescriptions will not apply

In addition, only for the Match Racing Series, by

- the Appendix C as altered by the MR SI,
- the RC 44 Match Racing SI Vs 2019\_01,

In addition, only for the Fleet Racing Series, by

- the RC 44 Fleet Racing SI Vs 2019\_01,
- the Addendum RC44 (see attached to the FR SI) will apply as altered by the FR SI, approved by World Sailing.

- 1.2 An IJ will be appointed, in accordance with RRS Appendix N, and the right of appeal will be denied in accordance with RRS 70.5.
- 1.3 Teams are only allowed to dive to clean the bottom of their boat from 08h00 to 10h00 each day from the moment the boats are in the marina until the end of the event. A formal request

may be made to the OA for permission to inspect the hull for underwater damage or in the event of a breakdown.

## 2 SCHEDULE OF RACES AND BRIEFINGS

### 2.1 PRACTICE & MATCH RACING SERIES

2.2 Practice fleet racing and match racing is scheduled on May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

2.3 Skippers shall attend the first briefing, which will be at 10h30 on May 29<sup>th</sup> in the Hospitality Area.

2.4 The first meeting with the umpires will be at the same time.

2.5 The intended time of the first attention signal on May 29<sup>th</sup> is 12h00.

2.6 Skippers shall be available for media requests, 30 minutes after the end of the last race each day.

### 2.7 FLEET RACING SERIES

2.8 The racing days are scheduled from May 30<sup>th</sup> through June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019.

2.9 Skippers shall attend the first briefing, which will be at 10h30 in the Hospitality Area on May 30<sup>th</sup>.

2.10 The intended time of the initial warning signal is 12h00.

2.11 On May 31<sup>st</sup> to June 2<sup>nd</sup>, briefing will be at 10h30 and warning signal at 12h00.

2.12 On June 2<sup>nd</sup>, No Warning Signal will be made after 15h30.

## 4 DESCRIPTIONS OF MARKS

### 4.1 MATCH RACING SERIES

The RC boat may be identified by RC 44 Class Association flag

Marks W and the Gate marks will be black.

Change marks used in accordance with SI M14 will be yellow as signalled.

The starting and finishing mark will be yellow.

### 4.2 FLEET RACING SERIES

#### Windward-leeward

Marks W, WI and WO will be black.

The Gate marks will be black.

New mark, as provided in instruction F14.1, will be yellow.

The starting and finishing mark will be yellow.

## 5 Radio communication

Race information will be given by VHF radio on channel 72.
